Aims of the workshops:

Before the questionable research practice occurs:

State of the art:

- what leads to questionable research practices?
- -What is already being done to prevent questionable research practices?

During (questionable) research practice:

How can researchers / students best be supported to help them avoid making mistakes that would be classed as questionable research practice or even fraud?

If questionable research practices happened:

How can questionable research practices be found out (with hindsight), and what should be done when a practice was questionable or there is a suspicion that it might be?
